

**Minutes of Meeting for inclusion of 1 (one) mining leases in approved District Survey Report (DSR) of Minor Minerals of Morigaon District held on 22/09/2025.**

The inclusion of 1 (one) mining leases in approved District Survey Report (DSR) of Minor Minerals for of Morigaon District as recommended by the SEAC after due evaluation and appraisal was taken up in the meeting of the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) under Chairmanship of Shri Rajesh Kemprai attended by Shri. Ramen Chandra Malakar, Member Secretary of the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority and Dr. Sarat Phukan, Member of the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority for due discussion and approval. It is on record that the Proposal for inclusion of 1 (one) mining leases was placed before the SEAC by the Morigaon District Committee and was appraised and recommended to SEIAA for approval of DSR on 22/09/2025. The same was thoroughly deliberated upon and discussed in the SEIAA meeting dated 22.09.2025.

**Observations of the State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC):**

Sri Kumar Ashis, Knowledge Partner for Morigaon District presented the case/proposal in person on behalf of the DFO before the august committee. The approved Mining plan & the MoM of the District Committee, Morigaon were also presented and explained before the esteemed committee:

It is submitted that the 2 (two) nos. of proposals earlier included in the approved DSR of Morigaon Dist (at Page No. 10 & con. SL 21. & 22) **Jagiroad Stone Contract Area F4** and **Jagiroad Stone Mining Contract area F5**, which shall stand cancelled / deleted from the approved DSR, and in its place the current proposal is being prayed to be included / added i.e **Jagiroad Stone Mining Area No. F(6)** in terms of the letter vide No. FNGT/B/74/ DSR Report/2025/5939-40 dated **05.09.2025**.

After reviewing the presentation and examination of the relevant documents, the SEAC unanimously agreed to recommend for inclusion of the proposed area in the approved District Survey Report (DSR) for Morigaon District by the SEIAA with **all the terms and conditions remaining the same** in terms of the approved DSR (Ref No- Memo No.SEAC.33/2013/Pt-I/334-A, dated 18.01.2025) for due compliance by the PP; the DFO, Nagaon Division and other stakeholders in district.

**General Conditions:**

I. Mining Plan and Environment Clearance for mining activity shall be in the name of the project Proponent only who shall apply accordingly.

II. No mining activity shall be allowed to be carried out / undertaken by any person without Environment Clearance and for any violation the primary stake holders shall be responsible.

III. The District Commissioner and other Regulatory Authorities in the district shall ensure compliance of the CPCB guidelines governing establishment of Brick Kilns and mining of Ordinary Earth by these units. For any mining permit in respect of Ordinary/Brick Earth for use in a Brick kiln, the PCB, Assam is required to furnish a compliance certificate regarding adherence of the guidelines of the CPCB by the Unit.

IV. The District Commissioner / concerned DFO shall initiate steps for sale of the Lease areas following due procedures involving Court cases, after due approval of the final DSR, seeking leave of the Hon'ble Court as the case may be in terms of the various orders passed by the Hon'ble NGT and the Hon'ble Apex Court wherein time and again it is reiterated about scientific mining on the basis of approved DSR.

V. The DFO shall submit all such cases through the knowledge partner for the district, all such proposal on private patta lands or Govt. lands which are not included or missed out from inclusion in the final DSR of the district for approval to this office for onward examination, discussion and evaluation through the window of '*environmental sensitivity*' to arrive at a common prescription for environmental safeguard.


VI. The period of validity of the DSR of Morigaon District shall be for the period of 5 years from the date of its approval.

VII. If any new lease is identified, its validity shall be **co-terminus** with the validity of period of the current approved DSR and the district Committee shall follow the entire procedure every time on the basis of existing DSR for any addition/up-dation.

VIII. The District Commissioner shall upload the approved DSR in public domain.

IX. The lessee shall periodically conduct audits of operative mine leases and take corrective measures in case of adverse observations and a yearly report on this shall be submitted to the SEIAA as a compliance report.


