<b>Name of Scheme</b>	Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY)
<b>Overview</b>	Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme launched in 2015 with the vision of “Har Khet Ko Pani” and “More Crop per Drop.” It aims to enhance agricultural productivity by ensuring efficient water use through expansion of cultivable area under assured irrigation, improving on-farm water use efficiency, and promoting water conservation technologies.
<b>Objectives</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Extend irrigation coverage to every farm (“Har Khet Ko Pani”).</li><li>• Improve on-farm water use efficiency to reduce wastage.</li><li>• Promote precision irrigation and water-saving technologies.</li><li>• Encourage sustainable water management practices including rainwater harvesting.</li><li>• Converge investments in irrigation at the field level for integrated development.</li></ul>
<b>Eligibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All categories of farmers are eligible.</li><li>• Priority is given to small and marginal farmers, SC/ST, and women farmers.</li><li>• FPOs, SHGs, and Cooperatives are also eligible under certain components.</li><li>• Beneficiaries should own cultivable land or have lease rights (as per state norms).</li></ul>
<b>Benefits</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Financial assistance for micro-irrigation systems (drip &amp; sprinkler).</li><li>• Support for construction of farm ponds, water harvesting structures, and check dams.</li><li>• Assistance for field channels, pipelines, and protective irrigation measures.</li><li>• Capacity building, training, and demonstrations on efficient water use.</li><li>• Promotion of Integrated Farming with water-saving interventions.</li></ul>
<b>How to Apply</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Farmers can apply through the District Agriculture Office, Morigaon.</li><li>• Beneficiaries are selected as per guidelines and state targets.</li><li>• ATMA and KVKs organize awareness camps for registration.</li><li>• Application forms are available at the DAO office and notified KVKs.</li><li>• Online application facility may also be provided through State Agriculture Department portals.</li></ul>
<b>Implementing Agency</b>	Directorate of Agriculture, Assam in coordination with District Agriculture Office (DAO), Morigaon, ATMA, and line departments like Irrigation & Horticulture.
