The meeting was chaired by Smti. Orpah Baglary, ACS, District Development Commissioner, Morigaon.

At the outset, the DDC welcomed all the members present in the meeting and explained briefly about the agenda of the meeting. The Chairperson emphasized the need for a discussion on CM Dashboard Indicators and requested the concerned departments to present the status of scheme-wise indicators.

The status of PMAGY and the draft VDP for 8 villages was discussed, and all concerned departments were requested to verify the schemes and number of beneficiaries in the draft VDP, whether undertaken by the departments or proposed by the VLCC—and submit the revised version with inclusions/deletions for DLCC approval within a week.

After the threadbare discussion, the following decisions have been taken:-
